



Anti Mouse Initiate Factor 3 Polyclonal Antibody

Initiate Factor 3 (IF3) is a novel gene isolated from mouse oocyte. IF3 is a secretory protein and expressed in oocyte, ovary and liver by mRNA level. It became clear that IF3 regulated differentiation.

This antibody was established from the purified serum immunized with partial peptide of mouse IF3. This antibody is useful for studying IF3 in liver and embryo.

Package Size 25 µg (100 µL/vial)


Format Rabbit polyclonal antibody 0.25mg/mL


Buffer PBS [containing 2% Block Ace as a stabilizer, 0.1% Proclin as a bacteriostat]

Storage Below –20 until needed.

Purification method This antibody was purified from rabbit serum by affinity chromatography.

Working dilution For Immunohistochemistry; $0.5 \sim 2 \mu g/mL$
